ICD-10 Provider Preparedness Annual Survey

Introduction

To help providers meet the ICD-10 compliance date of October 1, 2014, Massachusetts health plans and MassHealth conducted its **second annual** online ICD-10 provider progress survey to review preparedness efforts since the first survey was issued in late 2011. The results provide a baseline for statewide compliance efforts underway in the provider community and will be used by health care organizations to develop education strategies and to identify ICD-10 resources.

Executive Summary

The survey was issued to the Massachusetts provider community and consisted of a series of questions designed to assess ICD-10 planning and preparations underway within the provider community. The survey response period was four weeks in duration and various communication methods were utilized in the outreach effort to encourage participation. This included use of statewide newsletters, e-mail, and other means available prior to and during the survey period.

Results include the following:

- Total survey responses: 576
- A majority of survey responses were received from the following: Physician Offices (38.9%), Allied Health Providers (11.3%) and providers that identified as Other (31.6%) which included additional allied providers, solo practitioners and specialty providers
- Thirty-two hospital and integrated health care organization responses were received
- Sixty-two percent of the responses were submitted by organizations with fewer than 10 employees
- Development of training plans and review of organizational system requirements were the most common activities that were in process or completed within organizations
- Lack of knowledge, staff and training capacity were noted as the top barriers in ICD-10 planning and implementation work
- Thirty-seven percent of respondents noted use of external billing services for claims coding and/or claims submission and 43% have started ICD-10 discussions with external vendors
- Seventy-two percent of providers indicated that they were somewhat or very likely to submit ICD-10 compliant transactions by October 1, 2014


